How to Map a Network Drive

Mapping a network drive on the E&H network is extremely helpful when you have to repeatedly collect data from the same network location. In order to map a network drive you will need to be logged into the college network.

There are two ways to map a network drive. The first way assumes you know the server name and folder name of the mapped location. The second lets you search for the server and folder.

Mapping a Drive by Name

- 1. Right -click on Network Neighborhood (or My Network Places) and select Map Network Drive.
- 2. Enter the path of the folder to be mapped, i.e., //EHCPDC/prof_share
- 3. Select a drive letter that is not currently in use.
- 4. Click OK.

Mapping a Drive by Searching

Note: You will still need to know where the folder is located on the network.

- 1. Double-click on Network Neighborhood (or My Network Places)
- 2. Select Entire Network
- 3. Select Microsoft Windows Network
- 4. Select EHC
- 5. Double-click on the server where the folder is located, i.e. EHCPDC
- 6. Locate the folder to be mapped, i.e., prof_share
- 7. Right-click on the folder and select Map Network Drive
- 8. Select a drive letter that is not currently in use.
- 9. Click OK.
