## ETLA 240: London Theatre, Culture, and Politics of Renaissance London

This program will complement what students have learned in their on-campus English and History courses through an intensive and immersive nine-day study abroad program in London including excursions to York and Stratford. It aims to provide a hands-on connection to England's persistent Renaissance culture in theatre, literature, architecture, and art. Students will engage in a detailed investigation of the interaction between sites of public entertainment, urban geography, and national governance during the English Renaissance.

In addition to expanding their knowledge of the cultural institution of the Renaissance playhouse, students will also further develop their understanding of Tudor and Stuart governance by exploring the architectural, artistic, and textual iconography of Renaissance monarchs present in London's National Portrait Gallery, National Gallery, British Museum, Tower of London, Westminster Abbey, and numerous other sites in London proper.
