

# STUDY ABROAD OPPORTUNITIES

## SPRING AND SUMMER 2009

### SPRING 2009

**E&H spring courses:** Classes meet regularly during the spring semester and include a study abroad component. The estimated cost includes airfare, ground transportation, lodging, entrance fees, and most meals (3 meals per day for Costa Rica).

#### **BIOL 340: TROPICAL BIOLOGY (COSTA RICA)**

**Prerequisites:** B or better in BIOL-210 & BIOL-211

**Estimated Cost:** \$2500.00

**Travel dates:** 15 days in May (after Commencement)

**Application Due:** October 1, 2008

**Course Description:** After discussing neotropical ecosystems during the spring semester, students travel to Costa Rica to analyze organisms and their habitats. Students explore the country, designing and conducting individual research projects at La Suerte Biological Station and concluding their trip on the Caribbean coast during the nesting of sea turtles. (4 credits). *Requires professor's signature; contact Professor McConnell at [gjmconn@ehc.edu](mailto:gjmconn@ehc.edu)*

#### **THRE 350/GNST 250: THEATRE AND CULTURE (BULGARIA)**

**No Prerequisites**

**Estimated Cost:** \$3500

**Travel Dates:** May 10-22

**Application Due:** November 7, 2008

**Course description:** During the semester, students study European history, politics, religion, culture, and arts and examine the works of various Eastern European playwrights from the point of view of the society and culture in which they were produced. In May, students travel to Bulgaria for tours of historic sites, performances, and master classes, gaining an understanding of the relationship between theatre and society. (3 credits) \$500 non-refundable deposit due with application. *Requires professor's signature; contact Biliiana Stoytcheva-Horissian at [biliana@ehc.edu](mailto:biliana@ehc.edu)*

## **MCOM 350: AUDIO PRODUCTION (AUSTRALIA & NEW ZEALAND)**

**No Prerequisites**

**Estimated Cost:** \$3800

**Travel Dates:** March 4-16

**Application Due:** October 1, 2008

**Course Description:** Students develop skills in audio mixing and multi-track editing for use in multimedia settings, including the Internet. Travel in Australia and New Zealand allows students to incorporate media skills with knowledge gained from experience of the local broadcasts of the Maori and Australian aborigines, which are often produced solely by and for those indigenous cultures. (3 credits) Full payment due Nov. 20.

## **GRMN 350: GERMAN LANGUAGE AND CULTURE (GERMANY AND AUSTRIA)**

**Prerequisites:** GRMN-201

**Travel dates:** May 12-21

**Estimated Cost:** \$3000

**Application Due:** October 1, 2008.

**Course Description:** German students are afforded an immersive foreign language experience, practicing their skills in Munich, Salzburg, and Vienna (3 credits). \$500 non-refundable deposit due with application. *Requires professor's signature; contact Marilyn Walker at [mwalker@ehc.edu](mailto:mwalker@ehc.edu)*

## **SUMMER 2009 FLORENCE SUMMER PROGRAM**

**No Prerequisites**

**Program Dates:** May 11-June 14

**Estimated Cost:** \$4,999 (may be lower if attendance is high)

**Early Application Deadline** (\$100 discount): December, 1, 2008.

**Final Deadline:** February 1, 2009.

**Description:** Students choose two of three possible courses taught by E&H faculty members Charles Goolsby and Laurence Hare, learning about Italian culture, the "New Europe" (GLST 450) and painting in Florence, Italy. Full-day tours to Siena and San Gimignano are included, as well as benefits such as membership to the British Institute Library. \$500 non-refundable deposit due with application. *No prerequisites.*
