Awards are funded in part from generous donations to the college by friends and alumni. Students can complete FAFSA starting October 1, 2017. Early submission of FAFSA or by the priority deadline of March 1, 2018 enables more potential need-based award/grant consideration. *(Federal Application for Free Student Aid (FAFSA) Required)*

<b>Federal Stafford Student Loans</b>	Up to \$5,500
<b>Federal Parent PLUS Loan</b>	Amount varies based on a parent credit check

**Financial Aid Process**

1. Apply for Admission: <a href="http://www.ehc.edu/apply">www.ehc.edu/apply</a>
2. Be Admitted to Emory & Henry College
3. Receive your Admission Merit Scholarship / Award Offer
4. File your FAFSA early! (Available October 1, 2017)
5. Receive your Financial Aid Award Letter
6. Decide on a payment plan and / or loan options

*The following information will assist you as you prepare for your first year at Emory & Henry College.  
Follow these steps for a financial aid package!*

**Investigate**—outside and private sources of financial aid. Check with your high school, local libraries, local businesses, civic organizations, and parent’s employer(s). Take advantage of free internet scholarship search engines, such as:

**File**—your FAFSA as soon as possible starting October 1, 2017. Go to FAFSA.gov to file FAFSA. Be sure to enter E&H title IV school code: 003709. After you file be sure to:

- **Review your Student Aid Report (SAR) to look for errors in your FAFSA**
- **Read all financial aid notifications and instructions carefully so that you will know your best options for payment**

**Finalize**—your financial aid award! Upon receipt of your award; review, sign and return to Emory & Henry. In addition:

- If selected for FAFSA Verification, a letter will be included in your award packet. All necessary steps must be completed by May 15, 2018.
- If applying for student and/or parent loans, complete all requirements by June 15, 2018.
- Virginia Residents—if you want to receive the Virginia Tuition Assistance Grant (VTAG) your application must be submitted by July 31, 2018.
- Speak to a representative about the convenient Tuition Payment Plan.

<b>12 Month Plan</b>	<b>Enroll by May 1, 2018</b>
<b>10 Month Plan</b>	<b>Enroll by July 1, 2018</b>
<b>8 Month Plan</b>	<b>Enroll by August 1, 2018</b>
