2. Be Admitted to Emory & Henry College
3. Receive your Admission Merit Scholarship / Award Offer
4. File your FAFSA early! (Available October 1)
5. Receive your Financial Aid Award Letter
6. Decide on a payment plan and / or loan options

*The following information will assist you as you prepare for your first year at Emory & Henry College. Follow these steps for a financial aid package!*

**Investigate**—outside and private sources of financial aid. Check with your high school, local libraries, local businesses, civic organizations, and parent’s employer(s). Take advantage of free internet scholarship search engines, such as:

**File**—your FAFSA as soon as possible starting October 1, 2017 by going to [FAFSA.gov](http://FAFSA.gov). Be sure to enter E&H title IV school code: 003709 and after you file be sure to:

- **Review your Student Aid Report (SAR) to look for errors in your FAFSA**
- **Read all financial aid notifications and instructions carefully so that you will know your best options for payment**

**\*\*Finalize**— your financial aid award! Upon receipt of your award; review and accept your aid. In addition:

- If selected for FAFSA Verification, a letter will be included with your award. All necessary steps must be completed by May 15, 2018 for fall entry.
- If applying for student and/or parent loans, complete all requirements by June 15, 2018 for fall entry.
- Virginia Residents—if you want to receive the Virginia Tuition Assistance Grant (VTAG) your application must be submitted by July 31, 2018 for fall entry.
- Speak to a representative about the convenient Tuition Payment Plan.
